



Addendum 1 Fence Repair On-Call Contract

September 8, 2023

Questions received and receptive answers are as follows and will be considered Addendum 1.

1. Is there a minimum amount of fence that we would be brought in for. Once we are brought in would we bill one of the mobilizations?

As this in an on-call contract, we do not know the minimum amount of fence that would be required at this time. The quantity provided in the bid form is an estimate and is for purposes of comparing bids on an even scale to determine the low bidder. Services could be for full replacement or could be for repair of existing fence. Upon each mobilization request, a cost will be submitted by the selected contractor for the specific amount of work required at that time (including that mobilization), to be approved by PIDC/PAID prior to performing the work.

2. For the bond – my bonding company is going to bill me for the bond amount up front for the contract amount and then we would receive a credit for work not completed. Do you have any thoughts on exactly how that would work, i.e., would I be able to bill that to you?

The cost of the bond should be included in the mobilization cost bid. It can be billed to PIDC/PAID up front. Any credit for work not completed will be returned to PIDC/PAID upon contract completion.

3. What is the duration of the contract?

The contract duration will be three years.
