- 1. Please forward the basis of design – specs, etc. – as we are interested in bidding.**
 - No MFR or PN - Decorative Post-Top LED Luminaires/Replacements (9K-13K lm) - Qty 653**
 - Selux - SACL series retrofit/control retrofit items - Qty 185-192**
 - No MFR or PN - Decorative Pendant LED Luminaires and Arms (9K-13K lm) - Qty 27**
 - No MFR or PN - Decorative Post-Top/Wall Luminaires (5K-13K lm) - Qty 12-21**
 - No MFR or PN - Cobrahead Street & Area Luminaires (4K-28K lm) - Qty 215 each type**
 - No MFR or PN - Network Lighting Control System (cellular LMS/NLC) - Qty 1264**
 - No MFR or PN - Photocells (standard, UL, dimming versions) - Qty 1264**

All available information is provided in the vendor submittal worksheet and also referenced in the pre-bid meeting presentation. Basis of design specs will not be provided. Sufficient information has been provided for manufacturers to submit what they believe are their best solutions meeting the RFP requests. The RFP also allows manufacturers to submit what they deem as the solution that best meets the request as well as alternate solutions they think should be considered.

- 2. Confirm the Navy Yard LED Street & Area Lighting Upgrade Distribution Services RFP is to furnish the lights and other material only and does not include installation.**

- 3. Will the installation be posted separately on the PIDC website? Do you have an approximate time frame for this?**

Yes, the installation bid will be posted separately on the PIDC website at pidcphila.com/contracts. The anticipated time frame for publication is July 2026, subject to change at PIDC's discretion.

4. Do we as a distributor need to sign and return both of the documents or just one? If it is just one, would it be the 00623 or 00624?

All contractors must sign and include the certificate of non-indebtedness, Section 00623, in their proposal. Any subcontractors involved must sign Section 00624 to include in the proposal. If no subcontractors are involved, Section 00624 is not applicable.

5. Does this job require BABA, BAA or other domestic preference certifications?

At this time, this project does not plan on using funding that requires BABA, BAA or other domestic preference certifications. If these certifications are ultimately required, they will be requested directly from the manufacturer partners selected.

6. OD Pole or Tenon size for existing poles on League Island & C. Green Park and Crescent Park. Do these poles match the 3.5 OD of the 600+ existing Selux poles, or are they different?

Not a relevant question for Distribution Services RFP. For the parks, the existing pole OD is not known. If this question is asked by manufacturers, they will be told to provide solutions that can handle 3.5” to 4” OD pole sizes.
